

Application – Propose or withdraw nomination for an interstate water supply work (71W)

What you need to do

Before filling in this form, applicants are advised to read the accompanying <u>guide</u> to Application to nominate or withdraw a nomination for an interstate water supply work under section 71W of *the Water Management Act 2000* (WMA).

If you wish to schedule a meeting, go to the <u>WaterNSW website</u> and complete the pre-application meeting form for your area.

Please complete the form with a black/blue ink pen and use BLOCK letters. You can also type directly in this form. Once completed, please print and sign the form.

Submit your application form

Application fee

You can pay the application fee by credit card, cheque or money order.

- If paying by credit card, please do not provide your credit card details in writing to WaterNSW. Once the application is submitted, we will contact you to process payment over the phone for all credit card payments.
- Cheques and money orders to be made payable to WaterNSW and posted to the above address.

Note: If an application has been accepted by WaterNSW, payment has been processed and a receipt has been issued, application fees will not be refunded.

Please ensure you complete the following check-list:

Section A - Must be fully completed with the following details • water access licence numbers • current share component • extraction component.
Section B – Must be completed if an interstate water supply work or group of works is be nominated. Insert the number of the water supply work approval for the water supply work or group of works to be nominated.
Section C – Must be completed if the nomination of an interstate water supply work or group of works is being withdrawn. Insert the number of the water supply work approval or group of works for the water supply works to be withdrawn.
Section D – The applicant/s details provided in Section D must be all holders of the access licence. Details –full name/s, address, email address, contact number – must be provided for all applicants.
Section E – On the application form may be completed. The contact person for this application may be an applicant or a third party acting for the applicant.
Section F – Signed by each holder of the Water Access Licence. If the applicant is a company, the application is to be signed for and on behalf of the applicant by two company directors, a director and a company secretary, a sole director/secretary or a duly authorised officer. Select the position of the signatory or signatories.
That this application form is scanned once signed by all applicants and posted to: • WaterNSW PO Box 398, Parramatta, NSW 2124 • or emailed to Customer.Helpdesk@waternsw.com.au . Please note that electronically submitted applications must copy in the email addresses of all applicants.
If the dealing is granted, it does not take effect until the transaction has been registered in the Water Access Licence Register which is administered by NSW Land Registry Service. The applicant is responsible for registering a dealing with NSW Land Registry Service. Refer to the guide for further information.
Note: The applicant must first submit their application to their state body and then submit a copy of that interstate application form with this application form.

It is an offence, under section 344 of the *Water Management Act 2000*, to make a statement that you know to be false or misleading in, or in connection with, this application.

- 1. that I/we apply to nominate or remove an interstate water supply works/groups of works as described in this application;
- 2. that this application will be determined in accordance with the *Water Management Act 2000* and any associated regulations or guidelines as in force from time to time, and that no right or entitlement shall arise pending determination of this application and that any such determination may be subject to conditions;
- 3. that the authorised contact person (where applicable) has my permission to act for and on my behalf in relation to any aspect of this application unless otherwise notified by us, and that WaterNSW will rely on information provided by the authorised contact person in its consideration of this application;

If an approval is granted, the *Water Management Act 2000* requires that various details relating to the approval are to be recorded in the Register of Water Approvals kept by the Minister. Information recorded in the register is publicly available.

Offences and penalties

It is an offence, under section 344 of the *Water Management Act 2000*, to make a statement that you know to be false or misleading in, or in connection with, this application.

A corporation found guilty of an offence against section 344 is liable to a penalty not exceeding \$2.002 million. An individual found guilty of an offence against section 344 is liable to a penalty not exceeding \$500,500. An access licence or approval may be suspended or cancelled under the *Water Management Act 2000* in certain circumstances. These include if the holder of the licence or approval is convicted of an offence under that Act.
