

T&Cs Warragamga Dam Excursions

Student numbers

You cannot bring more students than stated on your booking form without prior notification and approval.

Supervision ratios

To meet our safety requirements, we require that the following minimum adult to student ratios be met with a combination of <u>your</u> school staff and helpers.

Preschool- 1 adult: 5 students
Primary - 1 adult: 10 students
Secondary - 1 adult: 15 students
Home Education - 1 adult: 10 students

Duty of care

Teachers always exercise duty of care for their students. Parent helpers assist in supervising.

Safety requirements

All attending adults must read the WaterNSW Risk Management Assessment.

All attending adults must complete a site safety induction on arriving. Teachers must bring a first aid kit. It should be easy to carry.

Clothing requirements

All participants (including the bus driver) are required to wear flat, enclosed shoes. Open shoes such as sandals or thongs are not permitted.

Participants should be prepared for changing weather conditions, as parts of this excursion occur outside with little shade or cover. We recommend that everyone brings a water bottle and wears long sleeves and pants, hats, and sunscreen.

Excursion changes

Warragamba Dam is an operational dam site; we may need to change or cancel parts of the excursion. We will contact you at the earliest opportunity should we need to cancel.

Cancellations

Our high quality, free excursion is in high demand. If you are unable to attend your excursion, please notify us <u>at least four weeks before your excursion date</u> so that we can offer the date to other schools.
