Warragamga Dam Excursions



What are the costs associated with the excursion?

An excursion to Warragamba Dam is free. Entry to our grounds and parking are also free.



What time will the excursion start and finish?

A standard excursion begins at 10:00am and finishes at 1:00pm.



Do we need our bus for the entire excursion?

Yes. Please make sure your bus is available all day. If your excursion includes a guided tour component, the bus will be required to transport students to the dam. The bus bay is located on Production Ave, on the left of Haviland Park, on approach to our Visitor Centre.



What should we wear?

All participants must wear flat, enclosed shoes. Open shoes such as sandals or thongs are not permitted.

Participants should be prepared for changing weather conditions, as parts of this excursion occur outside with little shade or cover. We recommend wearing long sleeves, long pants, hats, and sunscreen.



What facilities are available?

Our grounds have many picnic shelters and toilets. At the end of your excursion, feel free to enjoy your lunch in our grounds.

You cannot buy food/drink on-site. All visitors will need to bring their own food and drink. Drinking water is available from bubblers and bottle refill points.



Will learning materials be provided?

Yes. We will provide your students with all required learning materials on the day. We recommend that high school students bring a clipboard and pen.



Can we bring parent helpers?

Yes. Teachers always exercise duty of care for their students. Parent helpers assist in supervising.
